



TICKET NEWS

Tickets and travel for Cheltenham Town's rearranged away trip to face Burton Albion in Sky Bet League One action are now available online and from the ticket office.

The Robins meet with the Brewers on Tuesday 16th April [7:45pm] at the Pirelli Stadium and visiting fans have been allocated seats in the Carling Stand and standing tickets in the Russell Roof Tiles Stand.

All tickets from the original fixture remain valid and if you are unable to attend the new date and require a refund you must return the original ticket to the CTFC ticket office by Monday 15th April.

Any tickets not collected from the Completely-Suzuki Stadium by the morning of Tuesday 16th April will be taken to the Pirelli for collection from the ticket office.

Ticket prices for the fixture are as follows with a £2 increase on matchday:

BRISTOL ROVERS



In the shadow of their neighbours and fierce rivals Bristol City, Bristol Rovers under Matt Taylor are setting out their stall to establish themselves again in League One.

The 2022/23 season was their first back in the third tier after a one year stay in League Two that ended in memorable circumstances as a final day 7-0 win over Scunthorpe United earnt them automatic promotion ahead of promotion rivals Northampton Town on goal difference. A 17th place

finish in League One followed which is being matched by the spot in 16th place they currently occupy this term.

A lot of the reasoning behind their previous five-year-stay at this level can be put down to the work of current Robins manager Darrell Clarke, who lifted the club from the National League to League One in two seasons before guiding the Gas to respective 10th and 13th place finishes. Another link between the two sides comes in the form of former Town loanee Elkan Baggott, who joined the Gas in January.

Baggott has been a common feature in the side since arriving at the club, playing in an impressive run of four wins in seven from the beginning of February before a sevengame winless run with no goals hit Taylor's side, seeing them fall from 11th to their current home in 16th.

It has created symmetry between their home and away form this season however, now with seven wins coming at the Memorial Stadium and seven on their travels. Hopes of making that eight wins on the road will be high going in to today's fixture after a 4-1 success at the Completely-Suzuki

Stadium last term as well as being unbeaten on Cheltenham turf in competitive fixtures since 2008.

Hoping to be key to upholding that proud 16-year run will be the experienced and talismanic forward Chris Martin, who has 15 goals to his name in 32 League One appearances this season. He has helped the club deal with the departure of star man Aaron Collins in January to Bolton Wanderers with fellow attackers Luke Thomas and John Marquis also in the goals. Antony Evans has provided the creative heartbeat behind them pulling the strings in midfield with 19 goal contributions in all competitions and has found assistance in the shape of club record signing Kamil Conteh from Grimsby Town behind him.

Maggies is a fantastic charity close to my heart, set up to support people and families suffering with the effects of cancer. They offer practical and emotional support to people with any type of cancer, at any stage, for free. They receive no government funds and rely on the generosity of their supporters. They focus on the things that really make a difference, such as financial worries, housing, help with managing stress and anxiety, as well as side effects of treatment and support for friends and family.

BOB'S STORY

Hi, my name is Bob and this is my story:

I was diagnosed with chronic fatigue syndrome in the 1990's. Over the years my mobility got worse and worse so I had a spinal MRI to find out why. The results of that MRI showed a tumour in my neck and changed my life. After taking a biopsy, the team decided they needed to operate and just a few weeks later, I was under the knife having the tumour removed.

Two weeks after the op, I had an appointment with an oncologist, they told me what they'd found and diagnosed a salivary duct carcinoma. There were estimated to be only about 200 cases worldwide every year at that time and over the next 6 weeks I began treatment and had 30 sessions of radiotherapy.

My oncology specialist nurse suggested that I visit the Maggie's centre at the hospital, just drop in for a cup of tea and a chat she said. What I discovered was a haven of support. As my treatment progressed it became clear that it was harder for my family and friends to deal with my illness than for myself as I spent a lot of time managing their expectations and their emotions but at times I just needed to focus on myself. This was where I realised the true value

of Maggie's. Having them there to support my family took a hell of a lot of weight off my shoulders and I've been raising funds for them ever since to ensure others can benefit in the same way that myself and my family have.

I completed the London Marathon in 2022 as part of Team Maggies and with various half marathons and numerous 10k events under my belt, I'm proud to be back as part of Team Maggies again for London Marathon 2024 where I will be taking part alongside my son Darren in my wheelchair.



Robins supporter Noah Millington started regularly coming to Cheltenham Town matches in the 2021-22 season with his dad John and sister Daisy, and they have now been season ticket holders for two seasons.

Noah was a Club Ambassador last season, helping raise awareness of autism and further celebrating an inclusive atmosphere in our football community.

He experienced being on the radio gantry alongside media professionals from the BBC, writing up match reports and experiences for the club programme and website.

Noah used his experiences at the club to share with his fellow pupils and teachers at Alderman Knight School through assemblies and notice boards.

The Millington family and Supporter Liaison Team worked together alongside the football club and Cheltenham Town Community Trust to explore the matchday experience for children with special needs.

Earlier this season, he also joined the Supporters Services Group for the dedicated Unite for Access match on 2nd March to welcome and chat to supporters.

What did it mean to you being a Club Ambassador?

It meant a lot to me. I had always wanted to do something regarding my autism. I knew I was capable of spreading awareness. The things I did while I was the ambassador really boosted my confidence, and I've had a lot of brilliant experiences with the club in general.

Talking to Dave Hardy [Support Services Group matchday representative] and working with the SLO Team, it feels like a real community and everyone's friends.

What's been your favourite thing about attending Robins matches?

It has to be the interaction between the players and fans. Luke Southwood, Sean Long, Will Ferry and [former Cheltenham Town striker] Alfie May all have gone out of their way to improve our experiences.

Sean Long always makes time for the fans. He recognises us straight away, and he's really good with my sister. I've accompanied him out on the pitch before [for the dedicated Autism Awareness match last season].

I also had a training ground visit, which was probably one of my favourite things that I did as the Club Ambassador. I got to play indoor cricket with the team, and I was treated as if I was one of the lads

What has it been like meeting more Cheltenham Town supporters?

Getting to know more of the fans has been brilliant. There's a lot more interaction. It brings a sense of family to it. Most people know each other where we sit in the main stand, and we all have a good chat.

What do you think is the best thing about the team right now? Darrell Clarke brought life back to Cheltenham. Before him, we were basically dead and buried. But the morale between the players, and the communication that I can hear going on the pitch is brilliant. They aren't just colleagues – they seem like a family.


