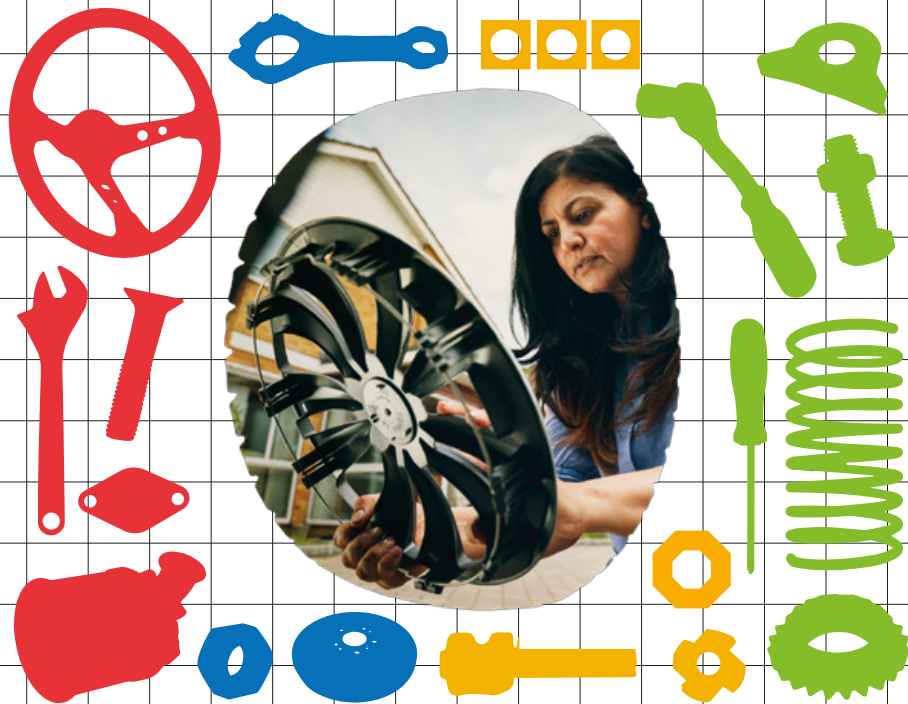

## CHAIRMAN DAVID BLOXHAM

**A very warm welcome to the Directors, players and staff of Northampton Town to the Completely-Suzuki Stadium for this afternoon's League One fixture.**

I believe we have to go back as far as the 2008/09 season when the two teams last played each other in the third tier, although in the intervening period there have been many fixtures in League Two, including play-off semi finals in both 2013 and 2020. Games between the two clubs are often close and exciting encounters.

To date we have played four league matches with three of those fixtures being played away from home and only one on home soil against Bolton a fortnight ago. Although results have ultimately been against us I do not feel that the performances have been poor with two narrow 1-0 defeats on the road and a hard earned point last Saturday at Portsmouth. A disappointing aspect of the season so far has been the number of injuries we seem to have accumulated and, to date, the lack of goals.

I know that Russell Milton has been working hard with the management team to identify and recruit additional signings with a view not only to covering our current crop of injuries but also to improve our squad and the competition for places. Throughout August, the club have been working hard to ensure that we are in the best position that we can be by the end of the month to have the necessary depth in the squad to be competitive in every game and climb up the table.

Last Saturday's fixtures provided a thrilling finish for Cobblers fans and a somewhat unusual situation for us watching the Robins at Portsmouth.



Whilst our visitors were scoring a 90th minute winner against Peterborough United, fans at Fratton Park were embarking upon 21 minutes of second half added time because of injuries to two match officials which resulted in an appeal being made within the stadium for a qualified official to come forward to run the line! After some delay a local league referee, Mr Julian Browning, volunteered to assist having spent the earlier part of the afternoon supporting Pompey and enjoying club hospitality.

This led to a dilemma for Robins boss Wade Elliott as to whether the game should continue for concern the club may be prejudiced by an opposition fan running the line. The outcome was that we agreed to the official running the line and the game ended in a 0-0 draw. For my part I offer credit to Mr Browning who I felt acted impartially notwithstanding his obvious support for Portsmouth!

I was delighted to read a short item in the Times newspaper entitled "Cheltenham's act of trust worth a medal". The article referred to the incident I have mentioned above and went on to conclude that "in a world of mistrust and suspicion this [our agreement for the Portsmouth fan to run the line] was a truly noble gesture, and Cheltenham were rewarded with a point. Come the end of the season the EFL should recognise this".

I hope that this afternoon's fixture does not provide a similarly unusual event and that all the officials safely complete the full 90 minutes! I am sure that the game will be a close and exciting encounter and hope the Robins can get on to the score sheet whilst maintaining a strong defensive performance.

## LUCIANO D'AURIA-HENRY

Cheltenham Town's eighth signing of the summer saw athletic wing-back Luciano D'Auria-Henry swap West London for Gloucestershire last Thursday.

The 20-year-old has been with the Cottagers since 2013 and is beginning his journey into senior football with a loan move to the Robins for the 2023/24 campaign. Despite being an unused substitute for Fulham's Carabao Cup tie with Crawley Town last season, the youngster is now ready for his first real chance.

"I'm buzzing," started D'Auria-Henry. "I've been waiting for an opportunity like this for a while now. I'm just ready to crack on and help the team. I've been waiting for it for a while to show what I can do and I'm very excited to get on with it."

Luci started out as a winger but has become more of a wing-back in previous years, a position in which he made 19

appearances in Premier League Two for the Cottagers last term. Craven Cottage has provided a great place to progress for D'Auria-Henry, but the move to Cheltenham is one he feels has come at the right time.

"Fulham is a great club but I think it is time for a new challenge in men's football as well so I can push on and start my career. The coaches and everyone around the training ground is of a very good standard. I can't complain."

The first venture into senior football away from the club you have called home for so many years can be an overwhelming experience for a young player like Luci. But the Robins have had no issues in making him feel right at home since his arrival.

"They've been very welcoming and looked after me since I've been here. I've just felt comfortable since I stepped foot in the training ground. The lads have been welcoming and helped me find my place in the changing room."

The attack minded defender made his debut for the club coming off the bench in the 0-0 draw against Portsmouth last weekend and is even more eager now to demonstrate his capabilities in front of the home crowd.

"I'm ready to show the fans what I can do at the next level and progress my career from here. Not many of them know who I really am so I'm just excited to show them what I can do and help the team."

**Northampton Town are embarking on a new start in familiar territory this term after confirming their return to League One in the 2022/23 season. They overcame their final day woes defeating Tranmere Rovers, after heartbreak on the final day of the 2021/22 season, that denied them an instant return to the third tier of English football.**



The Cobblers' 1-0 win over Tranmere secured a third-place finish in League Two, a finish that healed a lot of the pain players, staff and fans alike suffered after Bristol Rovers' 7-0 win stopped them earning promotion the season prior. The third tier is a level they have regularly visited with this being their fourth season there in the last eight years, but they have only avoided relegation in one of the three prior campaigns.

A club formerly managed by ex-Cheltenham manager Gary Johnson, Northampton are now under the stewardship of Jon Brady. After their first three games of the new season ended in defeat, fortunes have turned around of late. A 2-2 draw at home to Lincoln City was followed up with a late 1-0 win against Peterborough United in the Nene derby at the weekend.

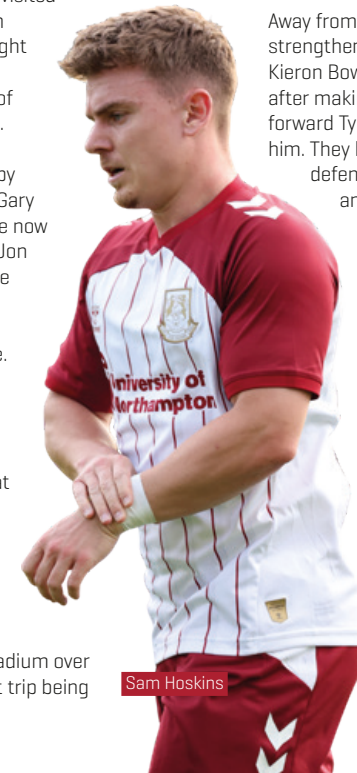
Continuing the Cheltenham links and Northampton have been frequent visitors to the Completely-Suzuki Stadium over the years, the most recent trip being

one Robins fans won't remember fondly with the Cobblers triumphing 3-0 to overturn a first leg deficit in the play-off semi-finals. However, it is a ground they have failed to win at in the league since 2013.

Away from the field they have been busy strengthening their squad in order to avoid the drop. Kieron Bowie has returned on loan from Fulham after making 40 appearances last season, whilst forward Tyreece Simpson will be lining up alongside him. They have also made reinforcements in the defensive areas in the form of Manny Monthe and Patrick Brough.

Crucially, the core of their successful League Two side remains with Sam Hoskins, their 22-goal man last season, at the forefront of that. Fellow forward players Pinnock and Louis Appere will be on hunt for a regular flow of goal contributions at a higher level while watching over them from the back will be the experienced Jon Guthrie.

The Cobblers' fanbase will certainly be hoping for an improvement on 22nd, where they have finished on their last two seasons at this level, and currently sit in 16th with manager Brady keen to avoid going through the stresses of a promotion fight from League Two again.

## IT'S #HERGAMETO

**In 2021, a group of passionate women fans felt mobilised to start a campaign called #HerGameToo.**

The campaign is committed to fostering an ethos in football where women are welcomed and respected equally and can be confident sharing their opinions about football online and in person without fear of sexist abuse. This afternoon, we introduce two new advocates to the cause.

Cheltenham Town's Her Game Too ambassador, Kelly-Marie Selby, tells us: "Growing up loving football, it was so sad that not only did girls not have the opportunities that boys had to further their abilities, but trying to voice my opinion was almost impossible. As soon as I tried to express any views I was told I was a girl, I didn't know anything about football, and I should just concentrate on make up and being a girl.

"The younger me shied away from fighting, but as I got older, I knew this wasn't right and that I should be allowed to join in on conversations about football. So when the opportunity came to become an ambassador of an amazing campaign to empower women to have a voice without fear, I put myself forward. Over the past few months I've been ambassador for Her Game Too Cheltenham, and this has now grown

with two incredible ladies coming on board - Mary Stone and Taz Scales.

"Together, we want to help create an environment at The Completely-Suzuki Stadium where women of all ages can feel welcome and safe without fear of sexism and misogyny, knowing there are avenues to report such incidents."

Introducing themselves, Taz explained: "53 years ago the ban of woman playing football was finally lifted, and now we are seeing woman on the big screens influencing the new generation. Her Game Too brings awareness to the struggles woman players and fans may face and how we can eliminate it. I am so excited to work alongside Her Game Too to raise more awareness and inspire the younger generations."

Alongside Taz and Kelly-Marie, Mary reflected on what the campaign is for her: "Her Game Too means being able to go and watch football games wherever I want, whenever I want,

without being made uncomfortable. In the short space of time I've been involved with this group, I've connected with so many female football friends, like Kelly and Taz, and sharing our experiences together shows exactly why we're doing what we're doing.

"I'd encourage everyone to find a way to get involved with Her Game Too, it could be through doing something so simple as wearing our badge or taking a more front facing role in tackling sexism in football."

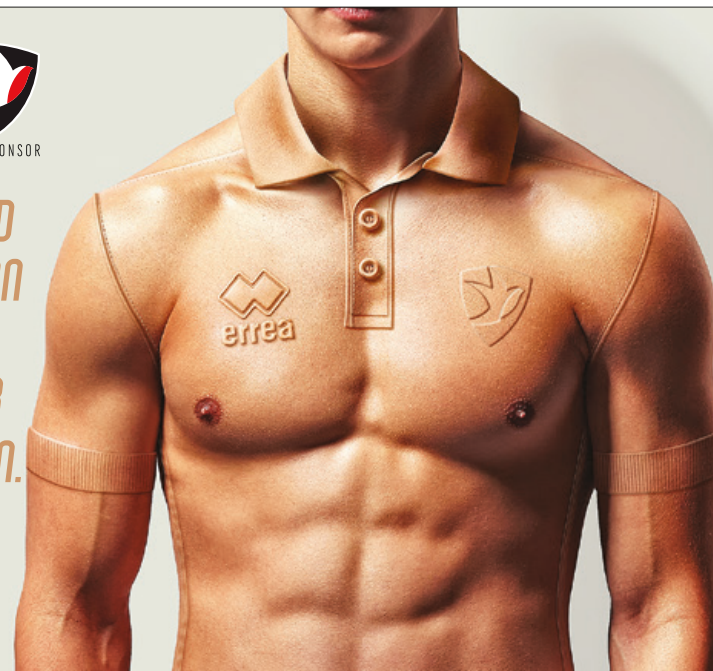
