- Upload session plan and complete evaluation on a weekly basis.
- Attend and provide input on the two ILP plus player and parent reviews and complete academy player competencies performance review on PMA.
- Add ILP comments on PMA and set new targets (if required) every 6/12 weeks.
- After every 6/12 weeks block add comment and attend multidisciplinary team (MT) meetings.

Talent ID

- Ensure trialist is assigned to an academy player to help them feel welcome and settle in.
- Complete players' training, match minutes and feedback by Monday evening on PMA.
