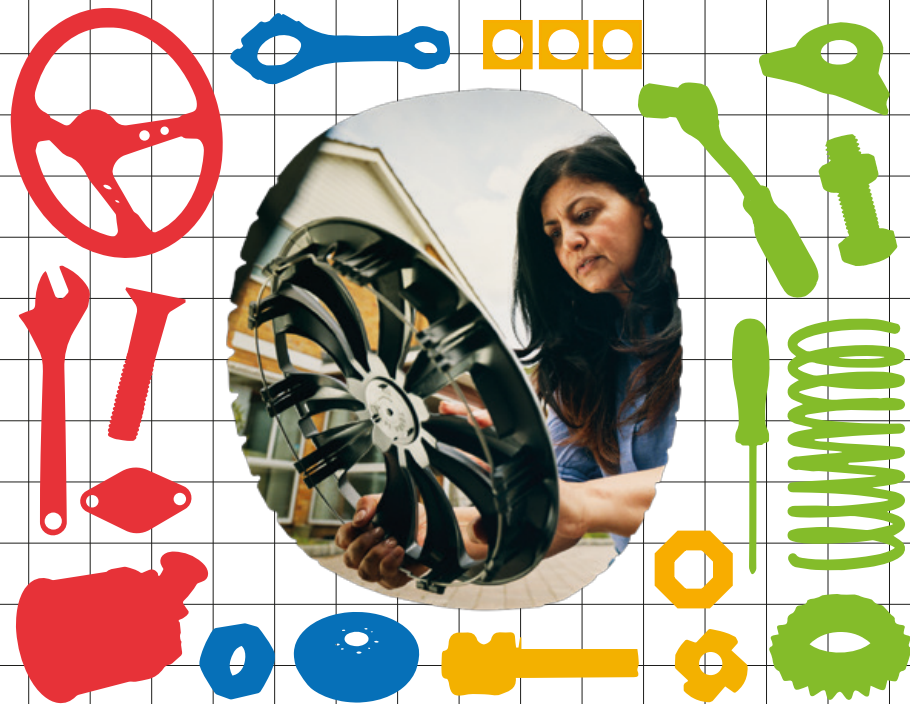

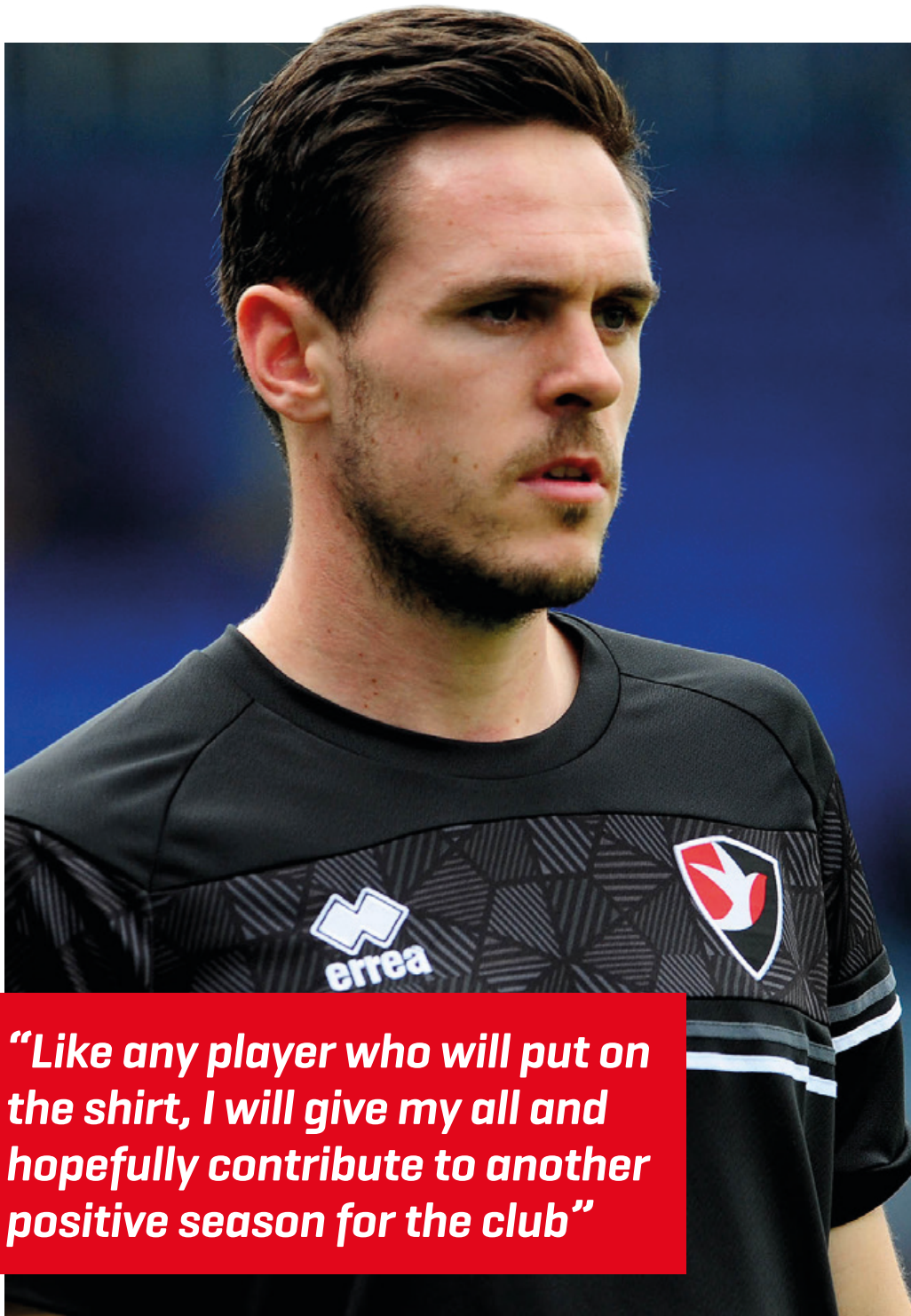

# LIAM SMITH

After returning from injury, Cheltenham Town defender Liam Smith is back and ready to become a Robins regular in Darrell Clarke’s new look side.

The Scottish youth international joined the club back in the summer as our fifth off-season signing after a short trial period at the club.

“It was nice to get in early,” said Smith upon signing.

“I met the boys, and they are all very welcoming and the staff as well. I feel comfortable here and I think it’s a good place to come.”

The 27-year-old joined up with the Robins after spending all of his professional career in Scotland with spells at Hearts, East Fife, Raith Rovers, St Mirren and most recently a four-year stint with Dundee United.

His time at Tannadice was certainly an important one for his learnings in the game, adding both a promotion and relegation to his CV.

“There were highs and lows. It was all positive up until last season when things didn’t go our way, but four years is a long time in one place, and I think it was time for a new challenge.”

Despite having spent all his time in his native Scotland, the defender hasn’t felt a noticeable difference after heading south to take on English football for the first time.

“It’s more similar in terms of standard and intensity to training. A



new challenge, something different, which at my age was important I did and get out and try something new.”

Smith is a versatile asset in the Robins squad, usually plying his trade on the right-hand side of defence. He’s played right back, right wing back and more recently on the right side of a back three at the Completely-Suzuki.

“I like to think I’m consistent and solid,” Liam continued.

“I like to contribute going forward if it’s that wingback role, you want to add goals and assists to your game

but also take pride, and the team take pride, in defending as well, so you want to be part of that too.”

This is the Robins’ third season in League One and Smith is eager to play an important role in extending that reign in the third tier.

It’s not been the easy start to his time in Gloucestershire, but Liam will be giving it his all to help turn the team’s fortunes around.

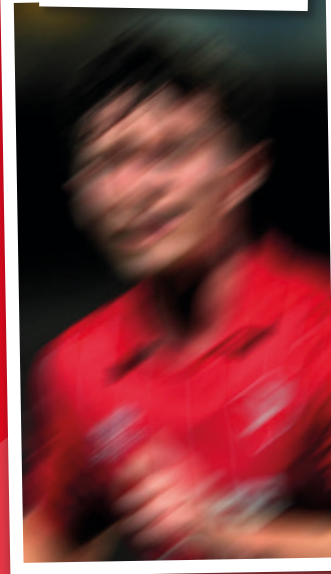

# PROSTATE UNITED



'Prostate United' is an annual fundraiser led by football club medical teams to run either three, five or 10 kilometers, or bike 10, 15 or 25 kilometers every day in the month of October to raise money and awareness of prostate cancer.

Head of Medical Gavin Crowe, First team Sports Therapist James Redman, Lead Physical Performance coach Sammy Gilchrist and First Team analyst Tom Carter have all been running five kilometres every day with goalkeeper Max Harris also joining the challenge and biking... After a year out, the CTFC staff are back supporting this great cause. In 2021 they raised £1500 for the charity and would love to beat that this time round.

The campaign started in November 2018 when at the time Rotherham United duo Stephen Gilpin and Ross Burbeary ran 10 kilometres every day. Their efforts have expanded in the last four years where more than 300 backroom staff from more than 60 clubs up and down the country run, cycle or walk every day of the month. This year, football fans are also being invited to join their club staff and take on either a daily walk, run, or bike ride. In another first for the challenge, Prostate United will take place in October this year, a month earlier than previous editions. 1 in 8 men will get prostate cancer. If you're over 50, or you're black, or your dad or brother had it, you're at even higher risk.

Prostate cancer can develop when cells in the prostate start to grow in an uncontrolled way. Some prostate cancer grows too slowly to cause any problems or affect how long you live. Because of this, many men with prostate cancer will never need any treatment. But for some, prostate cancer grows quickly and is more likely to spread. This is more likely to cause problems and need treatment to stop it developing. Prostate Cancer kills one man every 45 minutes, that's one half of a football match so it is vitally important to raise as much awareness as possible.



This year the Robins staff are determined to continue to play their part in helping to raise money and awareness of a cancer that impacts so many people. You can find out more about prostate cancer and the signs and symptoms online at [prostatecanceruk.org](http://prostatecanceruk.org) where there is useful information about what you should be looking out for and how you can take action if you have any concerns.

**Like Cheltenham Town, Cambridge United are in the midst of their third consecutive season in League One and are looking to hit new heights under manager Mark Bonner after a mixed start to the campaign.**



Their first season back at this level ended in a 14th place finish after their promotion winning campaign in 2020/21. However, it wasn't so easy last term, as a win over Accrington Stanley on the final day was just enough to preserve their third-tier status.

Several key figures from that survival success have now moved on especially in the attacking areas. Former Robin Sam Smith was the club's top goal scorer last term, but he has hopped across to Reading with Harvey Knibbs following in his path to Berkshire. Joining them both in leaving is fellow forward Joe Ironside who netted on six occasions himself last season.

Bonner and the board at the club moved quickly over the summer to replace them with Elias Kachunga the notable name arriving from Bolton Wanderers. Jordan Cousins and Sullay Kaikai also joined the Abbey Stadium outfit with the loan signing of John-Kyman Gordon from Crystal Palace complimenting them.

A name that stayed at the club over the summer is Fejiri Okenabirhie who has hit the ground running this season. Notching up seven goals for the season already, he helped the U's pick up four wins from their opening six league games including a win

over the high-flying Oxford United. However, that impressive start has been followed with no wins in their last six league encounters and subsequently they have tumbled down the table to 17th.

Around Okenabirhie, some of the key figures from last season have remained. James Brophy and Paul Digby in the heart of the midfield featured north of 50 times in 2021/22 whilst captain Michael Morrison is an ever present at the centre of defence.

Morrison had his moment in the spotlight with his goal last weekend and will be hoping for similar against the Robins, a side the U's lost too on both occasions by a 2-1 margin last season.

Their fans will be keen to leave Gloucestershire with all three points as Bonner and the squad look to press restart on their season as the busy winter period looms.
