



Bolstering the Robins' backline in January, Andy Smith is another youngster looking to forge his path in English senior football.

The central defender joined the club during the January transfer window from Hull City after spending the first half of the season with the Championship club.

"Ever since I knew there was a little bit of interest from Cheltenham, I was really excited by it and I wanted to come straightaway," said Smith upon signing for Town.

Originally born in Banbury, Smith spent his whole youth career with the Tigers before making his first team debut in the EFL Cup back in August 2021.

"Coming through the age groups and being a local lad to get into the first team and be a professional player for your hometown club is a dream for any boy, no matter where you are from," continued Smith.

"To be in and around the first team at the minute has been great, hopefully I've come out to get some more experience and minutes under my belt."

Loan spells at Salford City and Grimsby Town have allowed the 22-year-old to start shaping his career in the professional game. It's not all been plain sailing for Smith but he's gain some valuable experience.

"The Salford loan didn't go well as I didn't play as much as I perhaps would've wanted to but going to Grimsby off the back of that, getting promotion from the National League and playing men's football, it has been brilliant for me and helped me kick on a lot."

During his short career he has crossed paths with two of the current members of the Robins squad in George Lloyd and Elliot Bonds, who have both have helped him transition to life at his new club.

"Coming into a new club can always be daunting but the two boys have helped me settle in and the rest of the lads as well have been brilliant with me."

The attraction for many signings is having the opportunity to work for and play under manager Darrell Clarke and it is no different for Smith who is keen to take full advantage of his spell at the club.

"I've spoken to him a few times about coming here to enjoy myself and play my football. There's no pressure on having to perform well but coming here to enjoy myself and work hard."

Whilst his primary role is to keep goals out at one end, Smith scored four times during his time at the Mariners and Robins fans will be hoping he poses a similar threat in opposition boxes during the run in.

"From what I can see the boys are working so hard to get the points on the board we need so stick with us as the boys are sticking at it and working so hard. Hopefully if we stay on that the results will come."

Once of the Premier League, Charlton Athletic have recently become regulars in League One and find themselves flirting with the trapdoor to League Two.



Alan Curbishley led the Addicks to seven seasons in the Premier League during the 2000s, however the outlook has been very different since relegation back to the second tier in 2007.

Promotions from League One in the 2011/12 and the 2018/19 seasons have featured in a fluctuating period but for the 2023/24 season the focus is on staying in the league rather than earning promotion, as they currently occupy 18th spot in the league and sit four points above the relegation zone.

Nathan Jones has been in charge for just a month, after Michael Appleton was relieved of his duties, and the former Luton Town manager has earned seven points from his opening six games including a 2-1 win on the road against Derby County that put an end to an 18-game winless run for the Addicks that stretched all the way back to their success over the Robins back in November.

That win was also the club's first over the Robins in their history and on the night, it was Alfie May who netted twice against his old club. Goals elsewhere in the Charlton ranks have been a struggle for the South London outfit with a further blow coming in the form of Corey Blackett-Taylor's departure to Derby in January but they do remain the ninth best goal scorers in the leaque.

A key reason behind their current league position has been the amount of goals conceded. They currently possess the 19th best defensive record in the third tier and subsequently new boss Jones has looked to rectify that. Terell Thomas, Macaulay Gillesphey and Rarmani Edmonds-Green have recently been the three centre-back entrusted with bringing stability to the defence ahead of an important part of their campaign.

The Robins and Charlton Athletic shared four goals on the final day of the 2022/23 Sky Bet League One season when the two last met at the Completely-Suzuki Stadium.

Second half goals from Aidan Keena and Alfie May, on his last appearance for the club, ensured the club's second consecutive season in the third tier of English football ended on a positive note.

However, things didn't go to plan initially when Scott Fraser rounded Luke Southwood, after a loose ball fell to him, to put the Addicks ahead at the break.

A fast start to the second period had the Robins level after May's fearsome drive could only be parried by Ashley Maynard-Brewer, where Keena was on hand to add the finishing touch for his sixth of the season.

The forward duo linked up

again not long after with the roles reversed as Keena delightfully played May in behind, only for the goalkeeper this time to successfully snuff out the opportunity.

Further chances came and went for the hosts through Will Ferry and Ryan Broom before Elliot Bonds lost possession on the edge of his box and Jack Payne capitalised to give his side the lead for the second time in the 83rd minute.

There would be one last hurrah for May in the red shirt of Cheltenham though as his brilliant touch was matched by a superb left-footed effort at the near post to earn the Robins a point and a 16th place finish at a sun drenched Completely-Suzuki.



Adam's story

Unite For Access in association with Level Playing Field







Robins supporter Adam Collings regularly watches home matches from the Colin Farmer Stand sponsored by JM Weston Construction, he loves commentating on the game each week using his Dictaphone.

When Adam was seven months old, he was in the hospital for a lengthy spell due to a delay in his birth where he suffered breathing problems.

This left him in intensive care for six weeks with his family not knowing whether he'd survive, and if so, whether he'd walk or suffer severe brain damage.

This made his mother, Linda, push the best physio/cranial therapist and assistance she could find. Adam then started going to St. Roses Disabled School in Stroud to give him independence. He gained many friends there and had an active social life.

Later, when he moved to

Leckhampton, he quickly became a Cheltenham Town fan, and from then on, there was no other team for him.

His family and various helpers would take him to the ground, so he could get to as many home matches as possible. Sadly, Adam's mother passed away when he was just 16 years old, and his dad, Richard, passed away unexpectedly in December 2019.

When his aunty and now guardian, Shirley, phones him to see how the Robins did, he'll never say they lost. He instead says, "They nearly won."

Two years ago, Shirley sought the help of the Robins Trust to help Adam attend home matches, and Gavin Garthwaite kindly offered to help. They now watch the games together each week keep up the good work Adam and thanks for your support!

In 2021, a group of passionate women fans felt mobilised to start a campaign called #HerGameToo.

Cheltenham Town's Her Game Too ambassador, Kelly-Marie Selby, tells us: "Growing up loving football, it was so sad that not only did girls not have the opportunities that boys had to further their abilities, but trying to voice my opinion was almost impossible. As soon as I tried to express any views I was told I was a girl, I didn't know anything about football, and I should just concentrate on make up and being a girl.

"The younger me shied away from fighting, but as I got older, I knew this wasn't right and that I should be allowed to join in on conversations about football. So when the opportunity came to become an ambassador of an amazing campaign to empower women to have a voice without fear, I put myself forward. Over the past few months I've been ambassador for Her Game Too Cheltenham, and this has now grown with three incredible ladies coming on board - Mary Stone, Taz Scoles and Emily Moore.

"Together, we want to help create an environment at The Completely-Suzuki Stadium where women of all ages can feel welcome and safe without fear of sexism and misogyny, knowing there are avenues to report such incidents."

Introducing themselves, Taz explained: "53 years ago the ban of woman playing football was finally lifted, and now we are seeing woman on the big screens influencing the new generation. Her Game Too brings awareness to the struggles woman players and fans may face and how we can eliminate it. I am so excited to work alongside Her Game Too to raise more awareness and inspire the younger generations."

Alongside Taz and Kelly-Marie, Mary reflected on what the campaign is for her: "Her Game Too means being able to go and watch football games wherever I want, whenever I want,



without being made uncomfortable. In the short space of time I've been involved with this group, I've connected with so many female football friends, like Kelly and Taz, and sharing our experiences together shows exactly why we're doing what we're doing.

"I'd encourage everyone to find a way to get involved with Her Game Too, it could be through doing something so simple as wearing our badge or taking a more front facing role in tackling sexism in football."
