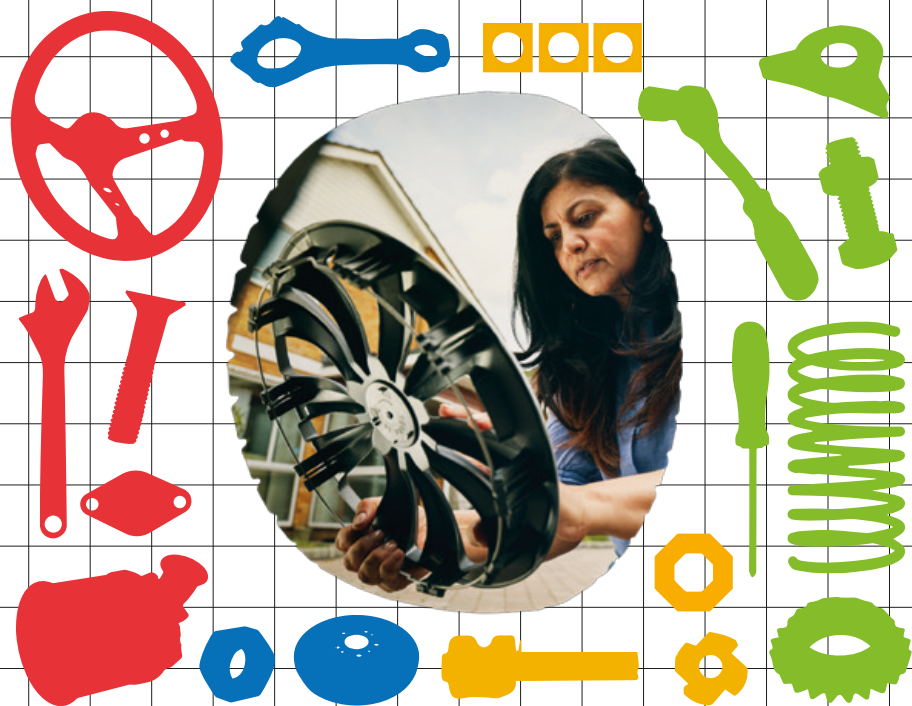

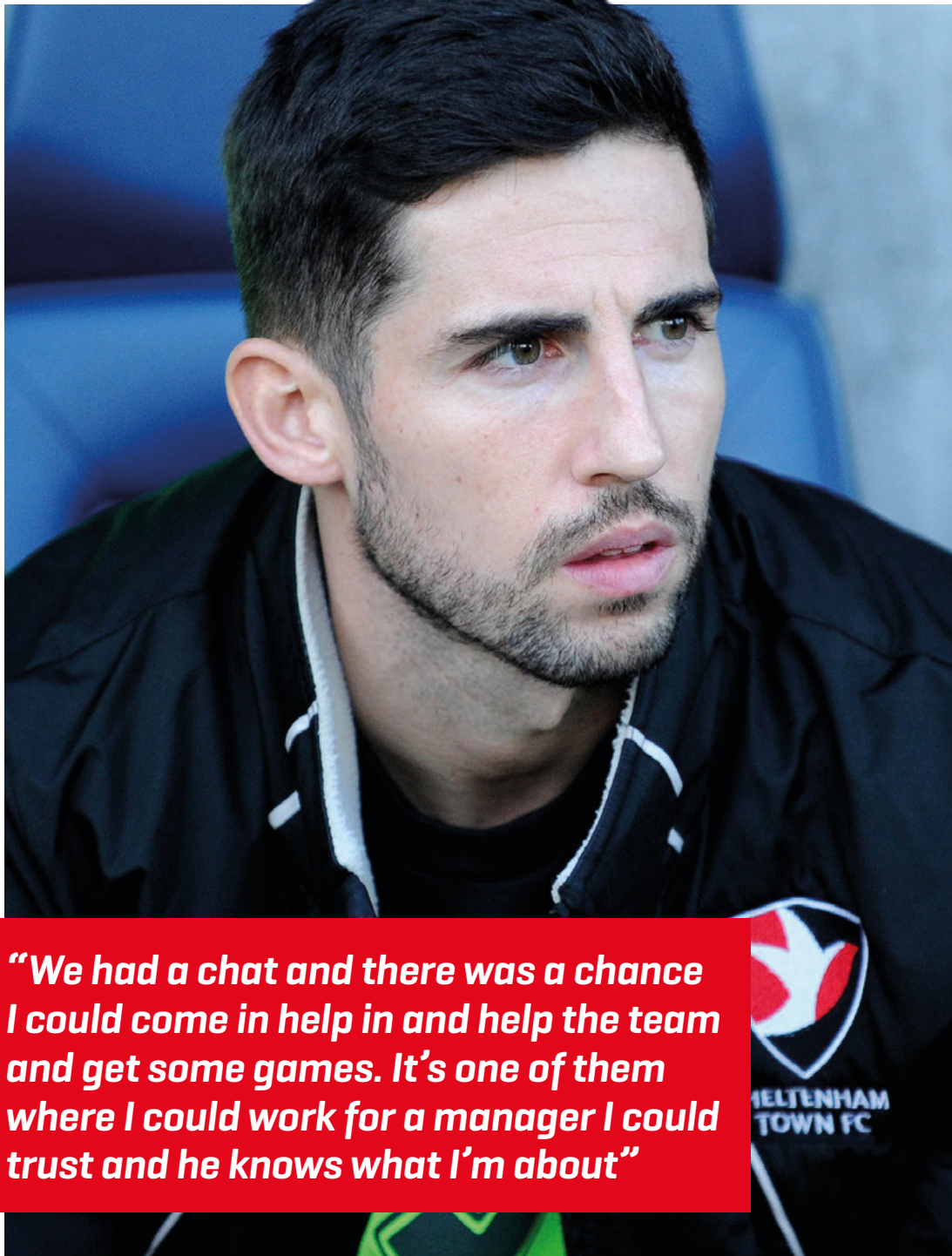

# TOM PETT

The transfer window may have been closed for two months but the Robins further bolstered their squad with the addition of Tom Pett last week.

The 31-year-old Englishman plies his trade in midfield and has spent close to 10 years in the professional game before becoming a free agent over the summer that eventually led to this new opportunity.

“I’ve been in touch with the gaffer for the last couple of weeks but the last few days it suddenly moved quickly and I’m really happy to get over the line and get out training,” said Pett after signing.

Him and manager Darrell Clarke previously worked together in his two-year spell at Port Vale, which included winning promotion to League One via the play-offs, a relationship that was key to Pett committing to the move.

“He’s been speaking to me for a few weeks, just checking in and seeing how I am mentally. We had a chat and there was a chance I could come in help in and help the team and get some games. It’s one of them where I could work for a manager I could trust and he knows what I’m about.”

His spell out of the game was one many footballers experience but upon reflection, Pett believes it was a beneficial process.

“You’d go to gym and do a few runs a week but nothing can replicate being in a football team. It was hard but



I’m glad I did it as at the time you picture yourself doing it for a reason and you can look back and get the success for it.”

Now being back involved at a football club on a day-to-day basis, the midfielder is keen to hit the ground running and use his abundance of skills to continue the Robins’ rise up the table.

“I’ll get the ball down and want to feed the attacking players in the team but also try and get us playing

and organised off the ball. One of my strengths is tactically reading the game off the ball.”

That knowledge is going to be integral as the season progresses alongside the motivation Clarke can provide.

“You can see what he has already brought into the team. The fight, everyone wants to play for him and the club and you could see that Saturday [Port Vale]. You will run through brick walls for him.”

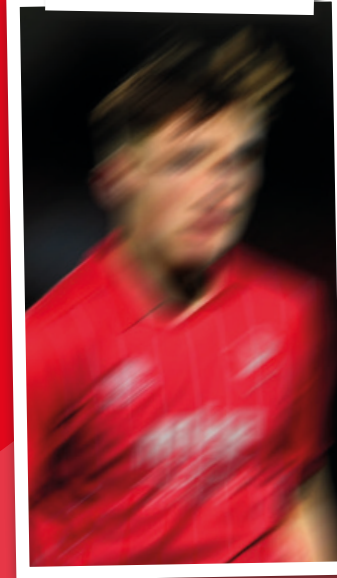

IGLU Bars and Food on the Move partnered to become our food and drink provider ahead of the 2023/24 season at the Completely-Suzuki Stadium. We've had some great feedback already so we sat down with IGLU owner Pete Geddes to talk about their first few months at the club and their future plans.



#### **Tell us a bit more about yourselves?**

We're called IGLU Bars, we're a Cheltenham based company and we've been going for nine years now. The business has grown and grown over the years, we're mainly centered on weddings and corporate events but we've dipped our toe into sporting events over the last few years.

#### **You mentioned sporting events, can you give us some examples that the company have been previously involved in?**

We worked with Bristol Rovers for a year doing bars and their fanzone which went really well and we have done a number of horse racing meetings over 8,000 people. And it was great to be able to get the contract at our home town club, really looking to grow things as in previous years, the experience hasn't been brilliant here.

#### **What's the set-up at the Completely-Suzuki Stadium with food and drink now under your provision?**

Well we are partners with Food on the Move who provide all the food and we take care of all the beverage. And so far we've had nothing but great feedback. On a number of things like speed of service and quality on both the food and drink front. Now we are just really encouraging supporters to try and get to the ground before the game and drink at the club.

#### **And you're quite forward thinking which is great for the club, what sort of ideas have you brought in or are planning to introduce on matchdays?**

We've had a DJ at games and will be looking to do so again as much as we can throughout the season. We've also got a loyalty card scheme we are launching at today's game which we are really

excited about, so make sure you pick yours up at any of the bars. And also we want to hear from you. We're open to any ideas from supporters so we can improve the experience to ultimately get more fans down to the ground.

#### **How would you sum-up the first few months in partnership with Cheltenham Town?**

It's obviously been a tricky start to the season on the pitch which might have discouraged people but things are on the up now so hopefully they will be



for us as well. It's been great to stop and speak with fans and we can't wait to keep hearing your feedback and improving the matchday experience. We're really enjoying it here and we don't just want to be here for a year or two. We want this to be a long term development where we grow with the club.

**Relegated to the third tier of English football amidst financial problems, Wigan Athletic are looking to find their feet again and push back up the pyramid.**

A run of four unbeaten at the end of the 2022/23 season wasn't enough to stop the Latics from sliding down the ladder with points deductions adding the final nails in the coffin. Similar penalties were placed on them before a ball was kicked in the 2023/24 season too.

However, that hasn't deterred them as Shaun Maloney's side have crafted eight wins from their opening 16 league games including a run of four unbeaten to kick off the new season too with an away win against Derby County amongst that. Since then, progression has been more akin to that of a rollercoaster but after a 2-1 win against Peterborough, they arrive at the Completely-Suzuki Stadium with five wins from their last six, including success in the FA Cup against fellow League One side, Exeter City.

Two figures key to that have been a pair of strikers in Stephen Humphrys and Charlie Wyke. Seven goals for the former and six for the latter have provided

the Latics with reliable goalscoring options up front, a luxury they didn't have last term.

Lining up alongside them have been some new faces with Martial Godo, on loan from Premier League club Fulham, providing three goals and three assists of his own with fellow signings Steven Sessegnon and Matt Smith playing squad roles too.

The Latics' notable addition in the summer was the return of a member of their 2013 FA Cup winning squad, Callum McManaman. After spells at several clubs in England and even Australia, the winger has returned to Lancashire and has forged new relationships quickly and effectively with a couple of goals to his name.

The Englishman is stepping into the shoes of James McClean, who was one of many players to depart the club in the upheaval and turnover of the summer months. Other notable names to depart was a long time servant of the club across two spells in Max Power as well as Irish striker Will Keane.

Those exits further rocked a ship in treacherous waters but Maloney and the squad have helped right that with their steady start to the new campaign and the Latics' faithful will be keen for a swift return to the Championship but a season of consolidation looks to be in store.

### GETTING TO KNOW CAZ MAY, FOUNDER AND DIRECTOR OF HER GAME TOO.

#### What made you decide to start Her game too?

Sexism in football has been a problem for far too long and we have always just accepted it. As a female fan myself, I have had lots of experiences both online and in person. With some of the worst experiences, they have affected me mentally to the point I struggled attending matches due to anxiety. I realised I needed to share my experiences with other female fans who understand it but there was never anywhere to go or anyone to talk to.

I needed a group like Her Game Too, so I took it upon myself to start it, and now we can support other women who experience sexism in football. Clubs also never understood the scale of sexism three years ago, so I realised we needed to make clubs aware so they can support their female fans. We now have reporting systems in all 73 of our partner clubs, with visibility

of the messaging of equality. We are slowly seeing a change, which is what we've desperately needed for so long.

#### Where would you like to see Her Game too in five years time?

We have achieved so much in two years and we don't plan on slowing down. As our friends at Kick It Out say - we won't stop until it stops! We aim to partner with all 92 league clubs and beyond. We want to go into schools and educate and secure funding so we can financially support upcoming grassroots girls teams, so they can continue playing the game they love. We are closely monitoring the percentage of women attending games - we hope to see an increase on that in the next five years

#### What are you most proud of since starting Her Game too?

I'm most proud of the network of strong women and male allies that I

have recruited on board this journey with me. I am so grateful for everyone who is doing their bit to tackle one of football's longest standing issues. To see so many men challenging their peers is huge for us as women in the game. Obviously having 73/92 signed up in just over two years also fills us with pride, and we are pleased to see so many clubs getting behind us.

#### Tell us a fun fact about yourself?

Her Game Too is completely voluntary so I do it all around my day job, which is working in television as a Junior Editor, currently making content for Disney+! I am currently working on a show with Ryan Reynolds, which will be out in 2025.
